### Seniors

- BL congratulated the efforts of the Junior Club. Would like to see some of the seniors assist next year.
- Left a copy of strengths and weaknesses from the combined meeting. Recognised that the junior committee has more structure and commitment to management. Unfortunately hard to get people to do the job in the seniors.
- Finance – acknowledged help for the juniors in assisting the seniors to pay outstanding accounts. Confirmed that seniors policy will be that if people do not pay their fees they will not be able to pay next season.
- Likely to struggle for enough numbers to fill 5 grades in 2010/11. Other clubs in the same boat – may need to look at possibility of merges.

### President's Report – CS

- Agreed we will award trophies for 16A's. CS has ordered trophies and included those based on the 1<sup>st</sup> half of the season.
- CS asked committee to consider what they will do next year eg stay on committee, coach etc. No answer required yet but need to look ahead to make sure we have enough coaches organised before next season starts. CS indicated he may not coach to concentrate on committee.

### CCJCA Delegates Report – TS

- Caps ordered for 12B's – premiers x 12 players.
- Monday 17<sup>th</sup> May CCJCA Presentation Night – Diggers @ Long Jetty. Caps for 12B's will be presented.
- No date set for rep trials – possibly late April, early May. Need to ask coaches who is worth nominating beyond existing reps.
- Existing Reps do not need to go to first trial.
- Coaches to get back to TS with nominees.
- U14's - BY advised Alexander White and Josh Barty for U15's should be nominated. Will need to check DOB.
- U12A - CS nominated Lewis Cavender for U13's.
- U11B - Possibly Sean Barnett and Dane Crocker for U12's.
- U16B - CW to advise.
- U10's - TS and Tony Belcher to nominate players for U11's. Possibly Tim Scarr, Lachie Shelley, Kyle Johnson, Nick Hughes, Ben Campbell.
- Development Squad. Delegates voted 5 – 3 in favour of reinstating the rep team for the U10's next year in place of development squad. Games will be 40 overs and only one team. TS/TB to nominate players – Jeremy Belcher, Jamal Shoaib and Joel Ryan suggested.
- Rule changes for next year requested. Will probably ask CCJCA to change points allocation for tie next year to 3 and leave draws at 2 to match up with Seniors and reward teams for playing instead of wash-outs.
